Bats and Rats update and Financial Need;

A friend encouraged me (Steve) today on the phone to make a financial need known to you. You might recall last month we mentioned finding bats and an indication of rats in the house. We hired a contractor who has successfully removed all 40+ bats from our attic, is cleaning up the excrement and is attempting to trap any rats, repair damage and to close up entry points primarily at the crawl space to the house through vents, screens, siding and openings near outdoor faucets, etc,. The estimate for work that we need to likely pay in the next 30 days is \$2,200.00.

With the ministry reorganization Steve has begun new responsibilities as Operational Manager in the Development department. Bill Pugh, former Athletes in Action President and FamilyLife VP asked Steve to serve on the department management team last month. Steve's role includes administrative oversight in areas of personnel, vendor

contracts, calendar and communications, operations and many special projects. The development department serves over 50,000 ministry donors annually and is responsible for \$13,000,000 revenue annually for the ministry that enables FamilyLife to be able to fund efforts in dozens of countries. The funding helps create new resources, recruit local volunteer teams and new staff, and provides for funding of scholarships for the Weekend to **Remember Getaway** marriage conferences around the country that result in 2,000 salvations annually.
