

When we were accepted, despite all of our flaws, we could hardly say, "No." Plus, over the years from 1992-1996, I had seen God's hand in our marriage, family and church placement and I didn't want to miss whatever else He had for me. So Susie and I chose to trust Him with this career change, too.

One of my favorite God stories came last Christmas (2012), when our local volunteer team leaders, Tod and Lori Kaddatz, gave me a financial gift after the Milwaukee Weekend to Remember event in October. Tod had been collecting aluminum cans from around his neighborhood in an effort to save enough money to buy an HDTV. Instead, the Kaddatz' were convinced that God was calling them to give that savings to us. They gave us a check for \$57. What a huge blessing! Two months later, at a FamilyLife Christmas party, there was a drawing for a 32-inch HDTV, based on the number of hosted events any staff member was responsible for hosting or having hosted that fall. Just moments before the drawing was to be held. Susie asked me if my name was in there, to which I said, "Yes." We looked at each other she said, "If we win, we're sending that TV to Tod and Lori.." I said, "Absolutely!" Two seconds later, my name was drawn as the winner! We sent the TV to the Kaddatz that afternoon and they got it a couple of days later. I asked their 17-year-old daughter to film the family opening the large box and then showed the video to the staff at a pre-planned staff meeting that I inserted myself into because of what God had done. That was so much fun! Oh, by the way, two weeks later, in another drawing, I again had my name called and God gave us the EXACT HDTV we had shipped to the Kaddatz!
